Requirements

- Have an upper-intermediate/advanced level of English

Key Duties and Responsibilities

Successful candidates joining the Commercial department will have different duties and responsibilities including, but not limited to:

- Support the development of new products in line with the Company's business strategy.
- Assist with the lifecycle of the product from ideation to market.
- Assist in the coordination and planning of events.
- Draft technical briefs detailing the product requirements which briefs will be used by the IT suppliers.
- Assist in the relations with all suppliers carrying out services for the team.
- Assist in preparing reports for the department.
- Support in the coordination of the different sales sources.
- Provide initiatives for internal and external communications.

Development of practices

Starting date: between 01/06/2023 – 31/08/2023 according to the participants' availability.

The internships will last between one to three months during the summer months, with days of 40 hours per week.

Those selected will have a mentor who will follow their evolution. In this way, the student will be able to improve their communicative and intercultural skills, acquire non-technical skills that are appreciated in the labor market and develop a more entrepreneurial mentality.
